How Can J Get Through This Present Trial? Remember, Remember! From Don Drake

I recently had open heart surgery. They saw the breast bone, pry it back to get to the heart, fix it, then wire it back in place. I don't remember much about the recovery room. After I was out in a private room, they kept offering me pain medicine. When I told them I didn't have any pain, they couldn't understand that. I was sore but no pain. This seemed so unusual to them and they kept saying, "Are you sure you don't want a pain pill?" Later I thought of the many hundreds of folks who were praying for me. I had prayed for my Radio Family many times and maybe now God was doing a little extra for me through their prayers.

Some medications they gave me did upset my stomach, but after they took me off some that my stomach couldn't handle, I was ok. Last week I went back to my surgeon. He said, "You don't need to come back I don't need to see you again." My other heart Doctor said, "Come back in six months." They think I am doing fine.

I have talked to some who had the same surgery and they tell me it will take a year to fully recover. Here I am four weeks after this surgery wondering how am I going to make it through these months of waiting. How can I get through this present trial?

I remembered God said to Israel, "You have forgotten the God that brought you out of Egypt" What a short memory we all have. We are so like the disciples. They took so lightly the supernatural feeding of thousands with just a few loaves and fishes. You would think they would be so excited announcing, Miracle Food fresh from God's oven, come get it while it's still hot.

Jesus performed this miracle twice, feeding five thousand one time and a crowd of four thousand the next. Yet a few days later, the disciples had completely forgotten an unbelievable miracle. It happened when Jesus warned them about the leaven of the Pharisees. The disciples thought he said this because they forgot to bring bread for their journey. Jesus said, "Do you not yet understand, neither remember the five loaves and the five thousand and how many baskets ye took up? Neither the seven loaves of the four thousand and how many baskets ye took up Matt. 16. The disciples watched these exciting miracles and yet a short time later they were filled with doubts and questions about having no bread. No wonder Jesus said, "Do you not yet understand, neither remember?"

This is one of our failings too, remembering those times when we were in some crises and became desperate before God and won a victory. This is how we make it through the trials of life, remember the times when God sent His rescue squad from Heaven and took charge of the situation and it worked for your good and His Glory.

When David volunteered to fight the giant Goliath, Saul said to David, "Thou art not able to go against this Philistine to fight with Him" David said unto Saul, thy servant kept his fathers sheep and there came a lion and a bear and took a lamb out of the flock, and I went after him and smote him and delivered it out of his mouth and the Philistines shall be as one of them. David was **remembering** his past deliverances.

Whatever crises you may be facing, just look back and remember past victories, God has not changed and He is still on call, and so desires to be trusted.
