Paul said, we are troubled on every side. They are not sent or allowed to happen to us to disturb but to make us stronger. God ain't pickin on you; he's polishing you to better serve him.

Faith is often disturbed by failure. Jesus didn't say be thou successful until death and I will give you life, but be faithful. Failure is an experiment that didn't work so get up and try again. Failure isn't final with the Father.

Faith can be disturbed by delay. Waiting for God to solve a problem or meet a need is always difficult. I was eight years getting the radio station on the air. That's a long time to wait and pray and keep my faith in gear. Moses waited many years before he was allowed to go down to Egypt and lead his people out. Delay can destroy your faith if you don't stay close to the Lord.

Faith can be disturbed by criticism. I learned long ago not to allow criticism to stop me. If you are going to do anything worth while for God someone will criticize you. Most of the time the person doing the criticizing is not worthy to be considered. Remember that old saying; no one kicks a dead dog. They did while he was alive but dead, why bother. Do you think any foot ball player would be so foolish as to tackle a man on his own team, yet some church members do.

Many preachers are leaving the ministry because they can no longer endure the cruelty from those few in the church that think they are called of God to be spiritual FBI agents for the church.

The Judgment will be a sobering, fearful reality for those who have been self appointed to police the church. And I believe it will be a fearful event for those who didn't have the courage or backbone to stand against such wrong doing. There is such a thing as sin of silence. I would hate to be tried in a court of law and have some church members as a witness because they don't want to get involved. That is the reason many churches are looking for a new preacher every year or two.

Is your faith mixed with doubt? We don't get faith by wishing, you can't catch it from someone else, faith cometh by hearing and reading the Word of God. We don't need routine Christianity but reality walking with God. It will be mighty popular on Judgment day.

We did have a lot of Blackberries and grapes this year and our children got to enjoy them for the first time. The sweet potatoes are still blooming. We have been enjoying them for a couple of months. I pull one or two up at a time to eat on. I must dig them before frost, but thought I would let them grow as long as possible.

Don was diagnosed with Langerhans cell sarcoma along with CLL in August. It is so rare there are no clinical trials. Mayo Clinic is the one who confirmed the diagnoses. The first Chemo treatment was very successful in removing a lump on his neck. It has taken it's toll on his body and he has been in the hospital two times. The Drs. have been able to correct each deficiency (low sodium, low white count). On the 13th he received a second Chemo treatment. He did not get sick and has tolerated it very well. In a few weeks they will do a PET scan to see how the chemo is working. Hopefully the cancer will be gone. We desire your prayers. God is faithful and whatever the outcome WDFB will continue to operate as usual.

Cindy is a precious jewel! She really keeps everything going when we need to be away. She is always looking out for us and ways she can help carry a load. She has been hauling around a load too!!! Don teases her about being a gravel truck! She carried a kidney stone around for a while....finally passed it, but not without pain. Please continue to lift her in your prayers too.

Thanks to all the volunteers and helpers during our time of need. When your troubles and trials come (and they will) it is so important you keep a good attitude and don't lose your sense of humor. Many songs we play have taken on a new meaning when you are going through the storm. I'm so glad God is still the Master Of The Wind.
